

Understanding the possible threats, the associated risks and the vulnerabilities will inform the decision to travel and direct us in how we plan and prepare ourselves, and how we ensure our people remain safe, secure and effective.

CRIME – This can range from complex organised crime to opportunist activity directly or indirectly affecting you and the functions you are engaged in

INCIDENTS – Either industrial, domestic or aligned to travel or other functions associated with the environment you are living and working within

MEDICAL – Relating to illness, injury, local disease and infection profile such as malaria or epidemics such as Ebola or Avian Flu Virus

ENVIRONMENT – Events, activities and occurrences such as extreme weather and geological incidents affecting a country, region or specific location

STATE – Political instability that could result in the involvement of military intervention, social unrest and the breakdown of the rule of law.

Our Travel Risk Management services are tailored specifically to manage your concerns and expectations and therefore enhance your safety and wellbeing whilst overseas.




These services are complemented by a sector leading intelligence platform providing us with detailed up to the minute information and intelligence about the threats and risks associated with your destination, and how they may be changing.




Our travel safety briefings are designed to provide you with a clear picture of your destination country and location.

The briefing will include:

- Intelligence based analysis of threats and risks to safety and security using our 'CRIMES' model
